CAV is currently seeking Community Outreach Specialists to deliver a Community Relations program to support CAV's Education and Outreach goals for SRV Canada VRS.

This is an exciting opportunity for a candidate who is fluent in ASL/English, and/or LSQ/French, Deaf culture savvy, well-organized, friendly, patient and likes people, and communicates clearly.

This position will be a 1-year contracted position and will report to CAV's Community Relations Manager.

Responsibilities will include:

- Working closely with CAV's Outreach Team Leader who reports to the Community Manager to ensure alignment with the CAV's goals and plan
- Organizing, preparing and delivering educational presentations at outreach events
- Planning, coordinating and running development programs that may target particular geographic regions and/or demographic groups.
- Managing friendly contacts with families, schools, community leaders/volunteers and organizations
- Creating positive publicity and enlisting public support through networking with the community and its surround

Candidates should have the following skills, experiences and qualifications:

- Comfort with networking and working collaboratively with organizations, services and schools
- Comfortable interacting with Deaf individuals of all ages, and the families of Deaf children and youth who use sign language(s)
- Basic PC and/or Mac skills and technical knowledge of how VRS works, CAV policies, how customers use it and a talent for communicating in a positive and entertaining manner (☺)
- A valid driver's licence

Job Location

We are interested in hiring individuals who live in various regions across Canada who will use their regional knowledge to create successful outreach events.

Salary and Working Conditions

These positions are offered as a part-time contract work, up to 20+ hours per week. Compensation will include an hourly rate for approved work plus reimbursement of approved expenses. The hours and rate will be negotiated based on experience. The Community Outreach Specialist will work from home and may travel to other regions to work with the team and/or to attend outreach functions.

(www.cav-acs.ca) is a not-for-profit corporation that has been mandated by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) to design, implement and oversee the delivery of video relay service (VRS) in Canada. VRS provides telephone calling for sign language users by allowing sign language users to connect by a video link to a sign language interpreter who will provide real-time interpretation of telephone conversations. **SRV Canada VRS** was launched across the nation on September 28, 2016 and provides service to customers in four languages, English and American Sign language (ASL), as well as French and Langue des signes québécoise (LSQ).
